

Permanency Options Planning (P.O.P)

Why is this class being offered? An important decision is about to be made on behalf of a child. The caregivers should be familiar with the available options, possible outcomes to the child as well as to themselves, and understand their part in the decision making process.

Who should attend this training? Relatives, non-related caregivers and foster parents requesting to provide permanency for a dependent child who is not likely to return to the parents' care by the Juvenile Court.

What is covered?

- Comparison of Rights and Responsibilities amongst the permanency options (Adoption, Legal Guardianship & Long Term Foster Care)
- Comparison of financial differences amongst the permanency options
- Emotional considerations
