

Recorded Real Estate Document Searches FAQ

There is a lien filed under my name and it is not my property or information, how do I correct this mistake?

The Clerk-Recorder Department records are indexed by name. There can be multiple people with the same name in the county. Most liens have the last four digits of a social security number. You will need to prove to the party questioning the lien that it does not belong to you with a copy of the lien and proof that the last four digits of your social security number are not the same.
