Rules

1. Parking pass is effective for one year from the date of purchase.
2. Misplaced, lost or stolen passes will not be replaced.
3. Parks with pay and display machines, parking pass will be validated and a receipt will be printed to place on dashboard of your vehicle. Parking citations may be issued if valid receipt is not placed on the dashboard of your vehicle.
4. Parking pass permits one vehicle to park on a day-use basis, subject to all County rules and ordinances. Vehicle owner assumes all liability associated with use of this pass. Valid at all County of Orange-operated regional recreation facility parking areas with controlled access gates or pay and display machines.
5. Parking pass may only be used once per hour. Example: If you enter a park at 10 a.m. and need to leave, you are able to return to the park after 11 a.m.
6. Disabled: Proof of disability based on State Vehicle Code or California State Parks Pass must be present to be eligible for discounted fees.
7. *Distinguished Veterans are veterans:
 - 1) With a 50% or higher service-connected disability;
 - 2) Who were held as prisoners of war; or
 - 3) Who are recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor.

Documentation to verify Distinguished Veteran status can be in either:

- Valid "Distinguished Veteran Pass" issued by the California Department of Parks and Recreation, or
- Confirming letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
