## High Points:

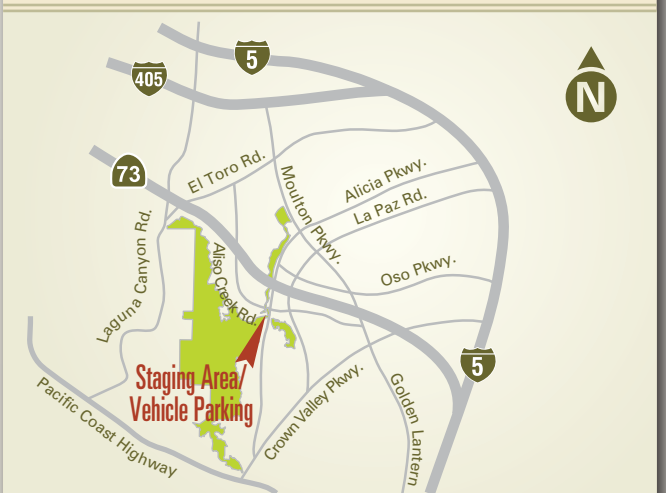
Some of the best views in the park can be had from the following locations:

- Aliso Peak: 683'
- Along the Aliso Summit Trail: 800'
- Top of Meadows Trail: 817'
- Top of Moulton Peak: 890'
- "Top of the World" at the end of Mathis Canyon Trail: 1036'
