Data Dictionary for Orange County Land Information System Public shape files

The Orange County Surveyor's Office (OC Survey), located within the Orange County Public Works Department, maintains a geospatial application known as the Land Information System (OC Landbase). The base layers are features used to maintain an accurate legal parcel layer of Orange County.

Effective November 2008, all LIS data has been migrated to an Oracle 10g version enabled database with all geometries stored as Oracle SDO_Geometry objects. All 'active features' at that time were adjusted to NAD 83, CA State Plane Zone VI, OCS 2007.00 adjustment; units are in US Survey foot.

Effective January 2012, deliverable OC Landbase features are processed into a warehouse schema where their Geometries are made compliant to both Oracle and ESRI ArcSDE standards.

Effective January 2014, licensed deliverables of OC Landbase features are available in shape file format. The following is a list of the licensed OC Landbase features.

Effective July 2015, all LIS data has been migrated to the ESRI Parcel Fabric data model within an enterprise geodatabase. The former unique identifiers for the Parcel Polygon features (mslink) have been replaced with "objectid" values.
