Super Bowl Sunday DUI Roving Patrols – Final Report

SANTA ANA, California (February 5, 2013) - The 2013 Super Bowl Sunday DUI crackdown on drinking drivers has ended and resulted in a significant number of DUI arrests from special saturation patrols and routine patrols in the Orange County "Avoid the 38" DUI campaign.

On Sunday February 3, 2013, officers representing 38 Orange County law enforcement agencies arrested 43 individuals for driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no DUI related deaths reported in Orange County during that day. (NOTE: These numbers are only provisional with some agencies yet to report.)

Law enforcement officials will be conducting more anti-DUI operations throughout the county and region during St Patrick's Day festivities in March. Police, Sheriff and the CHP encourage all motorists to help law enforcement every day by calling 9-1-1 to report drunk drivers.
