Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

The goal of SSVF is to promote housing stability to Veterans and their families by providing Housing assistance and Services if they are homeless or are at-risk of becoming homeless

Services Offered

Eligibility Criteria Includes:

- Served in the United States Armed Forces and is VA Health Care Eligible;
- Household income (household can be just the Veteran) must be below 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI) in Orange County;
- Veteran household is literally homeless (for example, living in a shelter, on the streets, in temporary housing), OR currently residing in permanent housing and at “imminent risk” of becoming homeless.

- Case Management
- Financial Planning
- Housing Location
- Referral Services
- Assistance in obtaining Veteran/Public Benefits
- Possible short-term Rental Assistance

Required Documentation Includes:

- Proof of character of discharge form DD-214
- Documentation of any income in the household
- Government picture ID and Social Security card for all adults in household
- Birth certificate for all children in household
- Notice of eviction if applicable (to document “imminent risk” of becoming homeless)
