The Park Ranger I class is considered an entry level position in the Park Ranger Series. There is no permanent status at the Park Ranger I level. Incumbents are expected to demonstrate progressive proficiency by performing work with increasing independence in order to advance to the Park Ranger II level after one year of appointment.
