NIGHT WORK: Villa Park Dam Water Release

OC Public Works will be gradually releasing large amounts of water from behind Villa Park Dam into Santiago Creek after Santiago Oaks Regional Park hours.



WHAT: OC Public Works will be gradually releasing large amounts of water from behind Villa Park Dam into Santiago Creek located within Santiago Oaks Regional Park. **Note: The release will take place after the park is closed and all trail access points within the park will re-open during normal operating hours the next day. The water release is scheduled to stop early in the morning to allow for proper drainage.**

As part of ongoing flood control maintenance, the release of water is necessary to reduce the potential for flooding. Project safety measures will be in place to ensure the safety of the public. Staff will also be on site until the project is complete. *The public is advised to avoid the project area during active water releases.*

WHEN: Beginning Sunday, May 14th, 2017 and continuing for approximately two weeks
Work Hours: 9:00 p.m. through 4:00 a.m.

WHERE: Villa Park Dam through Santiago Creek in Santiago Oaks Regional Park
