


Fee Study

- Auditor-Controller conducted a fee study review of OC Parks' costs to curate archaeological and paleontological materials:
 - Usable storage volume
 - Facility maintenance
 - Equipment
 - Staff time

 Concluded that proposed accession fee of \$2,657.05 per 1.3 cubic foot of archaeological and paleontological material is reasonable.



Fee Study



- The proposed accession fee was compared with other institutions throughout California.
 - Industry standard practice.
 - Comparable to San Bernardino County's accession fee.
